# Karasuzansho

("Japanese prickly-ash")



Grows in open sunny areas. Related to Sansho ("Japanese pepper"), its fruits have a similar spicy scent. The branches and the trunk have sharp thorns.

## Karasuageha

("Common Peacock")

Larvae of both species eat the leaves and the adults drink flower nectar



Adults found between April and August
