Enoki

("Japanese hackberry")



Birds flock to eat its sweet fruit in autumn (You can eat it too!).

Enoki(榎) means summer(夏) tree(木) because the large roadside trees provide shade in summer.

Who eats it?



Tamamushi

("jewel beetle")



Found between July and August.

Adults eat the Enoki leaves and larvae eat the dead trees of Enoki, Sakura ("Japanese cherry"), and Keyaki ("Japanese zelkova").
