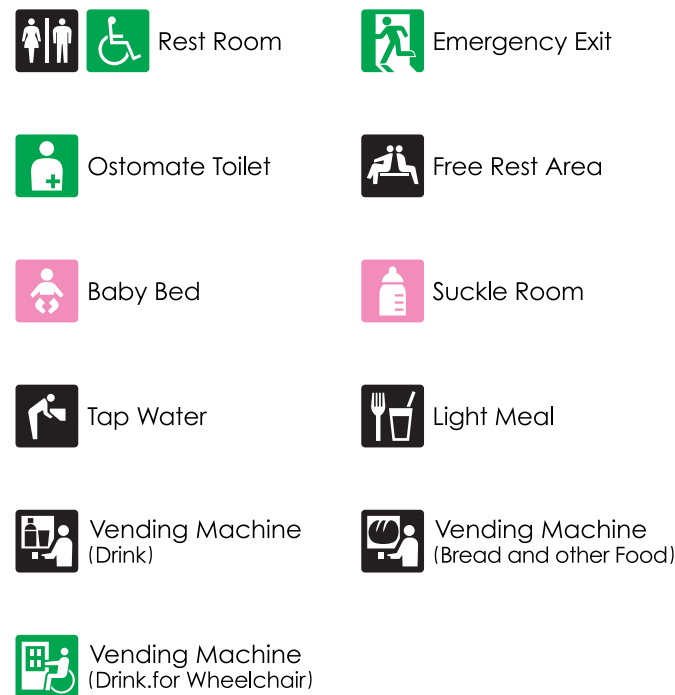


Welcome to Nogeeyama Zoo
